COVID Protocol & Worship Updates as of June 1

Following the announcements by the CDC and the PA Governor's Office, Zion is removing social distancing restrictions and lifting the mask mandate for fully vaccinated individuals in the building. We will follow the PA Governor's Office guidance on the lifting of the mask mandate on June 28 or when 70% of adults are vaccinated. We encourage all to prayerfully exhibit love of neighbor and respect for the wishes of those who choose to continue to social distance from others when in the building. We continue to request those who have a fever or who are not feeling well to remain home. Online worship is available for the 10:15am worship service on Sunday mornings. WOW (Worship on Wednesdays at 12:10pm) will continue online through the first week of September. Communion will be offered in-person and online on the 3rd Sunday and online on the 1st Wednesday. Pastor Karin is fully vaccinated and is available to provide home communion.

There are concerns (health and safety) and struggles (while we are without leadership from the choir) with congregational singing. A summer order of worship will begin on June 6 which will exhibit a consistent and simplified plan for music throughout the summer (June-August) when several members, leaders, and the pastor are planning to take times of vacation. The two hymns will be removed only over the summer. A second anthem will be added. Those, who may feel led to, may sing along with the anthem music while masked. Masking continues to be required for any singing in the worship space.

YouTube Broadcast Worship

In addition to continuing to worship with Zoom, we are offering a new method for congregants and visitors to join in Worship on Sundays and Wednesdays. We will be broadcasting worship on our YouTube channel using YouTube Live. The content of worship will be the same as attending via Zoom, however YouTube offers some differences, including:

- Anonymity Watching the worship service through YouTube is a similar experience to watching a video on your computer. Unlike participating via Zoom, there is no way for us to see or hear you during the service. Joining Worship this way is completely anonymous.
- More accessible Many devices such as Smart TVs and DVD players, Roku, tablets, and some cable boxes now come with the YouTube app built in. Just look for the YouTube Logo on your device.

How to join via YouTube: At worship time, open the YouTube app or go to youtube.com. Search for Zion Lutheran Church Harrisburg & select the result with a photo of the church as the icon. On our main page will be an alert that we are "Live," allowing you to join. We will start broadcasting 5 to 10 minutes before worship starts.
