We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. For the sake of your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that

we may delight in your will and walk in your ways, to the glory of your holy name. Amen.

L The Almighty and merciful God grant to you, being penitent, pardon for your sins, time for amendment of life, and the grace and comfort of His Holy Spirit.

C Amen.
