587 BC	Jerusalem temple destroyed
538 BC	Cyrus decrees that exiles may return to Judah
537 BC	Altar rebuilt in Jerusalem
516 BC	Second temple completed
458 BC	Ezra arrives in Jerusalem
445 BC	Nehemiah leads work on walls of Jerusalem
434 BC	Nehemiah returns to Susa
