Dear Members and Friends of Zion,

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

On November 29, we will celebrate the First Sunday in Advent and begin a new church year. In the season of Advent, we prepare to celebrate our Savior's birth and look to the time when our Lord Jesus will return. It is a time of preparation and waiting. A theme of waiting is very poignant to us as we await a vaccine and improved treatments for COVID-19. As we continue to take precautions which physically distance us from one another, may we be comforted by the assurance that nothing "will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 8:39).

We will continue to gather for worship, Bible Study, and other meetings online through the beginning of January 2021. Preparations are being made for Zion's sound and broadcasting system in the main worship space to be completed in December. We are hoping by Mid-January to be able to broadcast the 10:15am Sunday worship service over Zoom and YouTube from the church and to welcome in-person attendance, with proper protocols. We are committed to nurturing our fellowship together both for those who are ready to return to in-person worship and for those who, for a variety of reasons, will continue to attend worship online. Bible Study, Worship on Wednesday, and other meetings will remain online.

Advent is also a season of hope. This theme is reflected in several of our Advent hymns, especially, "Lift Up Your Heads, Ye Mighty Gates" (Service Book & Hymnal #8), based on verses from Psalm 24.

Lift up your heads, ye mighty gates: Behold, the King of glory waits! The King of kings is drawing near, the Savior of the World is here.

Fling wide the portals of your heart: Make it a temple, set apart From earthly use for heavens employ, Adorned with prayer and love and joy .

Redeemer, come! with us abide: Our hearts to thee we open wide, Let us thy inner presence feel, Thy grace and love in us reveal.

May the hope, peace, joy, and love of Christ which we celebrate in Advent be with us throughout this coming church year and always.

YouTube Broadcast Worship

In addition to continuing to worship with Zoom, we are offering a new method for congregants and visitors to join in Worship on Sundays and Wednesdays. We will be broadcasting worship on our YouTube channel using YouTube Live. The content of worship will be the same as attending via Zoom, however YouTube offers some differences, including:

• Anonymity - Watching the worship service through YouTube is a similar experience to watching a video on your computer. Unlike participating via Zoom, there is no way for us to see or hear you during the service. Joining Worship this way is completely anonymous.

• More accessible - Many devices such as Smart TVs and DVD players, Roku, tablets, and some cable boxes now come with the YouTube app built in. Just look for the YouTube Logo on your device.



How to join via YouTube: At worship time, open the YouTube app or go to <u>youtube.com</u>. Search for Zion Lutheran Church Harrisburg & select the result with a photo of the church as the icon. On our main page will be an alert that we are "Live," allowing you to join. We will start broadcasting 5 to 10 minutes before worship starts.

Mats for the Homeless Donated to Bethesda Mission

Over the past two months, Zion has been donating mats to Bethesda's Mobile Mission to the Homeless. The mats come from a ministry which was started by a ladies' group at the Crossroads Bible Church in Bedford, PA. They take plastic grocery bags and crochet them into 3 foot by 6 foot mats. A shoulder strap is also made to make it easier to carry the mats. The mats are lightweight and dry very quickly. They provide a barrier with the ground for the homeless to sleep on. Other churches from Lovely, PA and New Baltimore, PA are also making the mats and donating them to Crossroads for distribution. Originally, the mats were distributed by a truck driver when he sees homeless folks on his routes. With the number of mats being made, Crossroads was looking for additional ways to distribute the mats and serve a larger area. Dave Calhoun's brother attends Crossroads and reached out to him to see if Zion would be interested distributing the mats in the Harrisburg area. When Dave travels home to Bedford, he picks up available mats and brings them back Zion.

Bring the Annual Christmas Dinner to Your Home!

Chef Todd is sharing his almost-famous glazed ham recipe.

HOLIDAY HAM WITH APRICOT GLAZE

Makes 8 to 10 servings

- 1 (7 to 8 lb.) fully cooked, bone-in spiral cut ham half
- 1 (18 oz.) jar apricot preserves
- ¹/₂ C bourbon (or apple juice/cider, ginger ale, lemon/lime soda)
- 1/2 C whole grain mustard
- 2 T dark brown sugar
 - Preheat oven to 325°. Place ham, cut side down, on a lightly greased (with cooking spray) rack in a heavy-duty aluminum foil-lined broiler pan; let stand at room temperature 30 minutes.
 - Stir together preserves and next 3 ingredients in a saucepan. Bring to a simmer over medium-low heat. Simmer, stirring occasionally, 2 minutes. Remove from heat, and reserve 1¹/₂ C. Brush remaining glaze over ham.
 - Bake ham, uncovered, on lowest rack 2 hours or until a meat thermometer inserted in the thickest part registers 140°, basting every 30 minutes with reserved glaze. Let stand 15 minutes before serving.
