Dear Members & Friends of Zion,

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

During the upcoming Ash Wednesday Service on February 17, we will hear the following invitation from the Prophet Joel, "Return to the LORD your God, for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love" (Joel 2:13). With these words, our 40-day Lenten journey begins. It is a time during which we examine ourselves and honestly assess ways in which we have turned away from the God who creates, redeems, and sustains us. "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16).

God loves us and has saved us through Jesus Christ. In the midst of the tremendously challenging times in which we are living, we may forget this truly Good News. We doubt God is with us, and we worry about the present and the future. Jesus said, "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life ... But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you" (Matthew 6:25, 33).

The disciplines of Lent: alms-giving, prayer, and fasting, help us turn our focus back to our Savior Jesus Christ. Fasting is not simply a giving up of certain foods, but a reorientation of our outlook. The money that we don't spend on the food from which we're abstaining can be put toward Christian ministry and outreach (alms-giving). Fasting can also apply to our use of time. We may reorganize our schedules; fasting from time engaged in computer games, movies, social media, etc. to spend more time in prayer and Bible study.

Through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus, the Kingdom of God has broken into this world. By the Holy Spirit, Christ's power and peace are with us as we await His return. May seeking the Kingdom of God and living within it be our priority in the weeks ahead and always.

Worship Update: Broadcasting from Zion & In-Person Worship

This month, February, we have planned a first test of the broadcasting system in Zion's worship space at a time other than Sunday morning. After successful tests, we will broadcast a Sunday morning worship service from Zion. Online attendance on Zoom and YouTube remains the same as it is now. Following a successful Sunday morning worship service broadcast, we plan to open the Sunday morning worship to in-person attendance with COVID protocols in place. We are offering in-person worship as an option for those who feel comfortable with that choice and will continue to offer online worship and fellowship to nurture the faith and practice of all in the congregation. The date of the first in-person service and protocol details will be published when the schedule has been established.

Holy Week & Easter: The start of in-person worship may impact this schedule. We will be publicizing the details at a later date.

YouTube Broadcast Worship

In addition to continuing to worship with Zoom, we are offering a new method for congregants and visitors to join in Worship on Sundays and Wednesdays. We will be broadcasting worship on our YouTube channel using YouTube Live. The content of worship will be the same as attending via Zoom, however YouTube offers some differences, including:

Anonymity - Watching the worship service through YouTube is a similar experience to watching a video on your computer. Unlike participating via Zoom, there is no way for us to see or hear you during the service. Joining Worship this way is completely anonymous.
More accessible - Many devices such as Smart TVs and DVD players, Roku, tablets, and

some cable boxes now come with the YouTube app built in. Just look for the YouTube Logo on your device.

How to join via YouTube: At worship time, open the YouTube app or go to <u>youtube.com</u>. Search for Zion Lutheran Church Harrisburg & select the result with a photo of the church as the icon. On our main page will be an alert that we are "Live," allowing you to join. We will start broadcasting 5 to 10 minutes before worship starts.
