**Day 1– January 5**

**Confession “I am sorry”**

**Jesus Prayer**

**Read Psalm 32**

And Your love.

**Prayer**

We are sorry, Father, for not always following the wise directions of our parents, guardians, and teachers. Make us obedient and respectful of all who care for us. We ask this in Jesus name. Amen.

I thank you God, with all my heart.
