Dear Members & Friends of Zion,

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

These days, I find it harder to get up on time, because it's dark in the morning. Recent cloudy days have made it worse. The ongoing strains of the pandemic add to the gloomy atmosphere. It feels like the Scripture verse below:

If I say, "Surely the darkness shall cover me, and the light about me be night."

But that lament actually leads to testimony of about the nature and power of God:

"even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is bright as the day, for darkness is as light with you" (Psalm 139:11-12).

And, as Christians, we remember that God's power and light came into this world through God's Son, our Savior Jesus Christ, who said, *"I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life" (John 8:12).*

COVID Protocol & Worship Updates

We are committed to keeping the Zion community connected in worship and prayer. Our main Sunday 10:15am worship service will consistently be offered in-person and online. Both are important, because there are members who are not able to access the online service and there are others who, for a variety of reasons, are not able to come to the building. At all activities in the building, people may choose to mask and to social distance.

We encourage all to prayerfully exhibit love of neighbor and respect for the wishes of those who choose to continue to mask and to social distance from others when in the building. We continue to request those who have a fever or who are not feeling well to remain home. Online worship is available for the 10:15am worship service on Sunday mornings.

WOW (Worship on Wednesdays at 12:10pm) will continue to meet online only. Communion will be offered in-person and online on the 1st and 3rd Sundays and online on the 1st Wednesday. Pastor Karin is fully vaccinated and is available to provide home communion.

When attending in-person on Sunday mornings, the Chestnut Street Garage is a good option for parking. Current and functioning validation tickets are available on site at Zion. Regarding Altar Flowers, Zion will continue to utilize artificial arrangements through the end of 2021. Many thanks to Judy Reynolds for procuring the beautiful seasonal arrangements.

YouTube Broadcast Worship

In addition to continuing to worship with Zoom, we are offering a new method for congregants and visitors to join in Worship on Sundays and Wednesdays. We will be broadcasting worship on our YouTube channel using YouTube Live. The content of worship will be the same as attending via Zoom, however YouTube offers some differences, including:

- Anonymity - Watching the worship service through YouTube is a similar experience to watching a video on your computer. Unlike participating via Zoom, there is no way for us to see or hear you during the service. Joining Worship this way is completely anonymous.
- More accessible - Many devices such as Smart TVs and DVD players, Roku, tablets, and some cable boxes now come with the YouTube app built in. Just look for the YouTube Logo on your device.

How to join via YouTube: At worship time, open the YouTube app or go to [youtube.com](https://www.youtube.com). Search for Zion Lutheran Church Harrisburg & select the result with a photo of the church as the icon. On our main page will be an alert that we are "Live," allowing you to join. We will start broadcasting 5 to 10 minutes before worship starts.
